Mayor Fletcher called the public hearing to order. He stated the purpose of the public hearing is to allow public comment on the Town's application to Rural Development (RD) for funds to assist with the St. Paul I & I Downtown and West Hills Sewer Project to replace up to 13,500 linear feet of aging sanitary sewer lines throughout the Town of St. Paul and installation of approximately 8,000 linear feet of sewer in the West Hills area. Comments regarding economic and environmental impacts, service, area, alternatives to the project, and other related project issues are encouraged.

Ms. Baca explained that the Town did hold a public hearing and adopt a Resolution to Apply at the time of the original RD application to replace the downtown sewer. Three years later, it was decided to include the West Hills sewer into the same project. Since that was not included in the initial application, it was decided that the public should have an opportunity to speak on the combined project application for an amount not to exceed \$2,413,000 in RD funds.

Mayor Fletcher opened the floor for public comment.

There were no questions or comments from the public or council members. Therefore, Mayor Fletcher adjourned the public hearing.
